

## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

CITY OF WEST LINN, OREGON. 2014 PAVEMENT CONDITION ASSESSMENT. PROPOSALS DUE DECEMBER 3, 2014 at 4:00 p.m.

The City of West Linn is seeking proposals from qualified firms to conduct pavement condition surveys on the entire City of West Linn street system which consists of approximately 107 miles (215 lane miles) of roadway. Firms will be expected to collect and input all data into the City's StreetSaver database as well as analyze the data and calculate a pavement condition index for each of the City's Streets. Data must also be integrated with that provided in the City's Geographical Information System (GIS). A final report and presentation(s) of the data are also part of the scope of work.

Consultant selection will result in a contract for services and will be based upon criteria cited in the Request for Proposal document.

The City of West Linn reserves the right to reject any and all proposals not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, to postpone the award for 60 days, to delete certain items from the Proposal, to reject for good cause any and all proposals upon the finding that it is in the public interest to do so, and waive any and all informalities.
