

INVITATION FOR BID

CITY OF WEST LINN, OREGON
2017 SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION (PW-16-06)
BIDS DUE 3:00 PM, FEBRUARY 1, 2017

Sealed bids for the 2017 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project will be received by Erich Lais, P.E., Assistant City Engineer, at West Linn City Hall, 22500 Salamo Road, West Linn, Oregon, 97068 until 3:00 PM, Wednesday, February 1, 2017 when bids shall be publicly opened and read. Bids received after 3:00 PM on said day will not be considered. First Tier Subcontractor Disclosure forms shall be submitted not later than 5:00 PM on the same day. Bids shall be clearly marked "2017 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project (PW-16-06)." Bids shall be valid for sixty (60) days following bid opening. A pre-bid meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at 3:00 PM at West Linn City Hall. Statements made by the City's representatives at the pre-bid meeting are not binding upon the City unless confirmed by written addendum. This project is a public works project subject to ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870.

This project generally consists of CIPP lining approximately 30,000 feet of 8-inch, 7,600 feet of 10-inch, 200 feet of 14-inch, and 140 feet of 15-inch diameter sanitary sewer pipe with cured-in-place pipe. Also included is pipe cleaning and pre/post videos.

The project plans, specifications and contract provisions may be reviewed at no cost through the City of West Linn's website at <http://bids.westlinnoregon.gov/> or paper copies may be obtained through the City of West Linn Engineering Division at 22500 Salamo Road, West Linn, (503)722-5500, at a cost of \$50.00 per set. If you wish to receive any future addendums for this project please login to the City's bid management website and add your company to the plan holders list. Questions may also be submitted through the website.

The City shall consider no bid unless the bidder is registered with the Oregon Construction Contractor Board and the bidder has complied with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements. The City of West Linn reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to postpone the award for 90 days, to delete certain items from the proposal, and to award the contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
